- Analytic Plan linked to specific aims and hypotheses
- Sample Size/Power considerations
- Discussion of next steps
- Mentorship plan
- How research will advance global public health

 - Animal Subjects issues (if applicable)
- Details on other Funding (if applicable)
- Fellowship Timeline and Plan
- Plan for 1-3 months on UC mentor's campus (LMIC fellows)
- Biosketch following NIH guidelines
- Transcripts for doctoral and professional students
